Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services contracted with Partners in Prevention in 2021 to create a **multi-level violence prevention strategy** for use by institutions of higher education within Missouri. It is meant to focus on **encouraging a culture of care** and a **desire to engage** in potentially harmful situations. This monthly newsletter will provide stakeholders with a regular update on project progress.

WHAT ARE WE WORKING ON?

Finalizing and garnering feedback on the Overview training and associated facilitation guide.

Creating **train the facilitator materials** and planning for the implementation of these train the facilitator sessions.

Honing in on the content that will be included within the **first four deeper dive programs** (alcohol and other drugs, ide and acts of bias, mental well-being and suicidality, and interpersonal violence).

Finalizing **content for the engage online introductory training course** (we are refocusing this as an introductory training as opposed to using the term pre-matriculation training to better explain timinig for use of the program).

Focusing on the **logistics** of rolling the program out and how to assist our campuses in implementation of this strategy.
