

If you are involved in a crash - as a driver or a passenger - it is important to remember these important steps in order to stay safe after the crash.

Before exiting your vehicle, watch for on-coming traffic.

Check for injuries. If no one is injured, move your vehicle off the roadway. If you cannot move your vehicle, use flares.

Always call the police when an injury or fatality is involved, when the cars cannot be moved, when one of the drivers is intoxicated, when one of the drivers has no insurance, when there is damage to the vehicle, or when one of the drivers leaves the scene of the crash before exchanging information.

Exchange information. Use this card as a helpful tool.

Never leave the scene of a crash without exchanging information or calling the police, when appropriate. If you hit a vehicle that is parked, find the driver, or write your information in a note that you leave with the vehicle.

Keep this in your glove compartment for handy use in emergencies.
